

**GRACE GREENWOOD.**—GRACE GREENWOOD (Mrs. LIPPINCOTT, of this city), made an address on Tuesday night last, at the Tabernacle, in Jersey City, on "The Silver Lining of the War Cloud." The lecturer is a thoroughly loyal woman, and her energetic treatment of the Rebellion, or slavery as its cause and strength, and of sympathizers with treason, carried away the feelings and excited the patriotism of her New Jersey audience, which not only declined to hiss or be silent, but gave loud and enthusiastic cheers. An eloquent allusion to the President brought out rounds of applause, which, when they had died away, were three times renewed before the lecturer could proceed. **Nearly two thousand persons heard the address.**
